Selection of Tonearms

The Player comes with a Straight Tonearm and a S Shape Arm.

Straight Arm

The Straight Arm comes with a integrated Head shell. It is compatible with a wide range of (MM) and (MC) cartridges. We recommend to start with it first.

S Shape Arm

Its a Universal Tonearm that uses a Head shell. This makes changing cartridges or Head shells more convenient for use.

Pioneer JP 516 Tonearm
